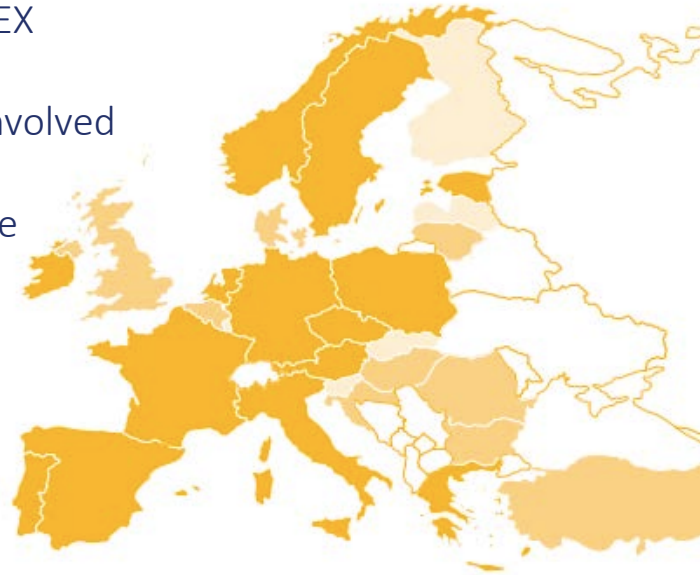

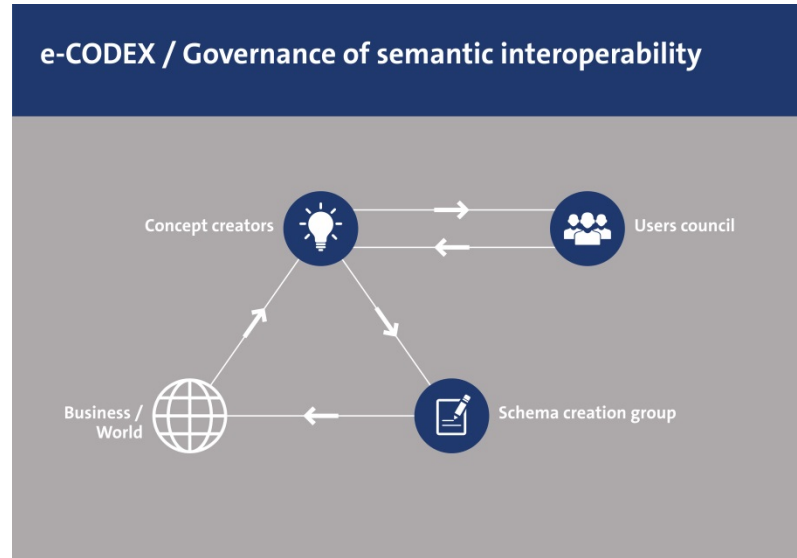
e-CODEX at the moment

- Increase of awareness in wider European Justice community

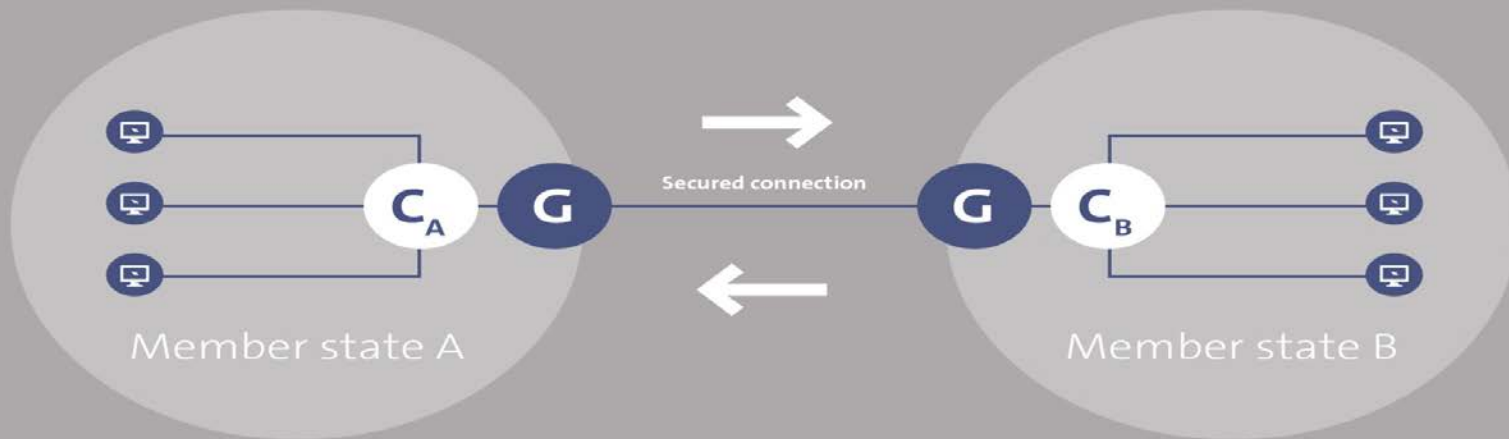


e-CODEX principles

- Subsidiarity:
 - Preserve national investments
 - Connecting, not replacing
- Semantic interoperability:
 - Speaking the same language

 - Interconnection of Insolvency Registers
 - Evidence2e-CODEX: exchange of electronic forensic evidence in European Investigation Order and Mutual Legal Assistance procedures
 - EXEC: connecting EIO back end solutions
