21/22 November 2022 - Vienna, Austria (and online)


## Organizational Information

### 1 Meeting Location

The Conference will take place at the ballroom of the Ministry of Justice:

**Ministry of Justice / Bundesministerium für Justiz**  
**Museumstraße 7**  
**1070 Vienna**  
**Austria**

If you take the Vienna underground, choose the **orange line U3 to “Volkstheater”**. (Attention: the **purple line U2** does currently NOT operate in the area between “Karlsplatz” and “Schottentor” due to construction works!). At the station “Volkstheater” take the exit marked with “Volkstheater” or “Museumsquartier” or “Burggasse” – not the exit to the “Ring”. Follow the footpath drawn in the picture below – just around the theater building of the Volkstheater – to get to the main entrance of the Ministry of Justice.



## 2 Online Participation

The Conference will be held in a hybrid format. It will be possible to participate online via Zoom. Connection details will be sent to registered participants before the conference.

## 3 Hotels

The “**K+K Hotel Maria Theresia**” offers a special rate for meeting participants. For stays between 20.11 – 22.11 the daily rate for a single room is EUR 135.- (incl. breakfast; +3,2% local taxes). There is a contingent of 30 rooms for this rate, which will be available until 2. November. Afterwards an availability cannot be guaranteed anymore. Reservations can be cancelled until 1 day before arrival free of charge.

If you want to arrive already on the weekend before or stay longer such an extension is possible but regular hotel rates might apply for the additional nights.

The hotel is located in walking distance to the meeting location, some Christmas markets, one of the main shopping streets and the U3 underground station “Volkstheater”:

## 4 COVID-Info

The current (mid-October 2022) COVID restrictions in Austria are as follows:

- For using the public transport in Vienna, you need to wear a **FFP2-mask**. A simple textile mask is NOT sufficient! For the flight and at the airport a FFP2-mask is not required by Austrian regulations (But some airlines might require you to wear a mask by regulations of the departure country).
- Besides that, FFP2-masks are only required in a few sensitive areas such as hospitals and pharmacies.
- Entering the country: There are currently no COVID related restrictions.
- It is possible that at the time of the conference more restrictions are in place due to rising COVID-numbers. Participants will be informed if new restrictions are introduced.

## 5 Getting from the Airport downtown

The most direct connection from the airport to Vienna is via the CAT – City Airport Train. The CAT takes you to “Wien Mitte / Wien Landstraße”, where you can change to the underground lines **U3 (orange line)** and **U4 (green line)**. The CAT operates every 30 minutes and takes 16 minutes. You can buy tickets at the green CAT vending machines at the airport train station or online.

Alternative, you can take the local train S7, which brings you to the same station as the CAT “Wien Mitte / Wien Landstraße”. The S7 operates every 30 min and takes 23 min to Wien Mitte (slightly slower than the CAT as it also stops in other stations, but it is also cheaper). You can buy tickets at the red ÖBB vending machines at the airport train station or online.

An alternative connection is the long-distance train Railjet (RJ, RJX) which also operates every 30 min and brings you in 15 min to the main train station of Vienna “Hauptbahnhof Wien”. This is further away from the city centre, but it might be closer to your chosen hotel and connects to the **red underground line U1** (it is also cheaper than the CAT). You can buy tickets at the red ÖBB vending machines at the airport train station or online.

## 6 Social Dinner and Cultural Activities

We will organize a social dinner at a traditional Viennese restaurant (**Zwölf-Apostelkeller, Sonnenfelsgasse 3, 1010 Wien**) at the evening of Monday, 21 November which will start at 20:00. Before we will offer cultural activities such as a guided tour around the city centre or a visit to a Viennese Christmas market for some “Punsch” or “Glühwein”. The starting time for these evening activities will be on Monday, 21 November around 19:00. Exact locations will be announced. The activities will end at the social dinner location.
